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VOTERS MUST RETURN BALLOTS IN CONSOLIDATED ELECTION BY TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3rd

The City of Chino Hills City Clerk's Office will assist the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters for the 2015 Consolidated Election by serving as a ballot drop off location. Ballots must be received by the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters by Tuesday, November 3rd. Voters who wish to mail the ballot should do so by Friday, October 30th. Voters who are concerned about mail deliver may drop off their ballot at the City's Clerk's Office on the second floor at Chino Hills City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, during normal business hours. City Hall hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Friday. City Hall will stay open late to receive ballots on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3rd from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Voters may sign up to receive a mail ballot by filling out the Mail Ballot Application found on the back cover of their Voter Information Guide, by downloading an application form the Elections Office website - www.sbcountyelections.com, or by calling the elections office at (909) 387-8300. The deadline to apply for a mail ballot is seven days prior to Election Day. Voted mail ballots may be returned via the U.S. Postal Service, in person to any polling place on Election Day, or to one of the 30 mail ballot drop-off locations prior to Election Day.
