**OCTOBER 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup>  
PEYTON DRIVE, ANOTHER ROUTE WILL BE A BETTER ROUTE  
OVERNIGHT CLOSURE PLANNED ON PEYTON DRIVE**

The Peyton Drive project bypass road will be in use during the morning commute and school traffic period on Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Another route WILL be a better route! Motorists on Eucalyptus Avenue will be directed to the bypass road and on to southbound Peyton Drive from Thursday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> at approximately 7:30 a.m. (after the Ayala H.S. traffic) till approximately 4:00 p.m. on Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Peyton Drive traffic will be directed to the bypass to avoid the area just south of Eucalyptus Avenue. Fall sports participants traveling to Chino Hills Community Park during the closure are encouraged to carpool and to travel to and from the park using the route from Chino Hills Parkway and Eucalyptus Avenue to avoid the bypass road and traffic.

PLEASE plan ahead for the traffic delays and allow extra time. Motorists with smartphones are encouraged to take advantage of the OxBlue app to check real time road conditions on the two webcams that are operational 24/7. For those with access to computers, visit [www.chinohills.org/PeytonConstruction](http://www.chinohills.org/PeytonConstruction) and click on the webcam photo to view conditions. Motorists are also advised to slow down in the construction area for the safety of the workers.

The decision to allow the closure was made to allow the contractor to complete paving work on Peyton Drive just south of Eucalyptus Avenue. Commuters and motorists whose destination is not on Peyton Drive are urged to avoid the area. This is the second time the bypass road will be in use during morning traffic with school in session.
