PEYTON DRIVE BYPASS ROAD TO BE IN USE 24/7

NOVEMBER 16th – 20th

The Peyton Drive project bypass road will be in use 24/7 starting after the morning school traffic (approximately 8:30 am) on Monday, November 16th to Friday, November 20th at approximately 4:00 pm. During the closure, the entire width of Eucalyptus Avenue will be reconstructed between Peyton Drive and the bypass road (near the Chino Hills Community Park entrance). Another route WILL be a better route!

Motorists traveling east on Eucalyptus Avenue near the entrance to Chino Hills Community Park will be directed to use the bypass road to Peyton Drive. Motorists traveling west on Eucalyptus Avenue will be directed south on Peyton Drive to the bypass road. Fall sports participants traveling to Chino Hills Community Park during the closure are encouraged to carpool and to travel to and from the park using the route from Chino Hills Parkway and Eucalyptus Avenue to avoid the bypass road and traffic. A message board is in place advising motorists of the closure.

Motorists are advised to avoid the area if possible or plan ahead for the traffic delays and allow extra time. Motorists with smartphones are encouraged to take advantage of the OxBlue app to check real time road conditions on the two webcams that are operational 24/7. Motorists are also advised to slow down in the construction area for the safety of the workers.
