POP-UP CITY HALL TAKES CITY INFORMATION OUT TO THE COMMUNITY VISIT LOWE'S AT THE COMMONS ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 16TH

Chino Hills, CA - The City of Chino Hills is taking City Hall out to the community with "Pop-Up City Hall" from 9:00 a.m. to noon on Saturday, January 16th at Lowe's, located at The Commons, 4777 Chino Hills Parkway. General City information about City services and programs will be available. The City's Utility Conservation Coordinator, Kelly Sandel, will be on hand to answer questions and provide information about saving water and the Stage III Water Alert. Visitors will receive a free collapsible water bucket and a water audit kit while supplies last. Lowe's will provide a display of drought tolerant plants for Pop-Up City Hall visitors to see. Information about water conservation rebate offers, water-saving tips for indoors and outdoors, and various handout materials will be available. Chino Hills residents who visit Pop-Up City Hall will have the opportunity to register early for a Free Workshop to learn more about efficient irrigation and how to benefit from rainwater. The workshop registration period officially begins on January 25th. The workshop will be held on Thursday, February 11th from 6:00 – 9:00 p.m. at the Chino Hills Community Center, 14250 Peyton Drive.
