Chino Hills, CA – Chino Hills residents are welcome to enjoy hot nutritious lunches on weekdays through the Senior Nutrition Program. The program is offered Tuesday through Friday, from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the Chino Senior Center at 13170 Central Avenue, in Chino. Home-delivered meals are also available. The Senior Nutrition Program is funded by the City of Chino Hills through the Community Development Block Grant Program.

To be eligible, you must be a Chino Hills residents 50 years of age and older. Participants will be required to complete a form and provide proof of residency. There is a suggested donation \$3 for seniors 60 years of age and older, and participants 59 years of age and younger are required to pay \$6. Reservations are not required.
