Tours will take place from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. with a wine reception to follow from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the Chino Hills Community Center. Tickets are \$45 per person which includes the reception. Reception-only tickets can be purchased for \$30. The reception will feature a live and silent auction.

The tour will feature three impressive properties located in central Chino Hills. The tours are self-guided, and numerous docents will be on-hand to share information about the homes.

Sitting high atop the hill overlooking Carbon Canyon Road and Chino Hills Parkway, one of the three homes has stunning views. It once received notoriety when it was operating illegally as a business in a residential neighborhood. It gained attention for being a boarding house for pregnant women. The property has since been completely renovated and now serves as a family home.

The second home is a brand new 2016 property in Vellano Estates that showcases luxury living for today's modern family. Its refined European sophistication and attention to detail are coupled with an inviting warmth that make it a spectacular home. With expansive views, this home is a masterpiece of upscale living in Chino Hills.

The third home on the tour showcases a 28-year-old residence that has been completely remodeled by longtime homeowners. They recently finished a significant remodeling project that completely upgraded the exterior and interior of their home. The manicured, spacious one-acre lot will give guests an enjoyable outdoor tour as well. It is bound to kick start anyone's creative ideas for their own home renovations.
