PLANNING COMMISSION APPLICATIONS SOUGHT FOR AN UNSCHEDULED VACANCY Applications Being Accepted May 30 – June 17, 2016

Chino Hills, CA – Residents who are interested in serving on the Planning Commission are invited to complete an application for consideration. Mayor Art Bennett will review the applications and make a selection to fill an unscheduled vacancy created after long-time Planning Commissioner Karen Bristow submitted her resignation because she is leaving the area. Mrs. Bristow was appointed to the first Planning Commission in February of 1992 by the late Mayor James S. Thalman. Applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's Office on the second floor at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, June 17th.

The Planning Commission meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. to review issues related to development and building and safety. The Commission also reviews site plans, amendments to the Development Code and General Plan, residential designs, design standards, and development standards.
