Fire Investigators Seek Public's Help

On October 21, 2016, at 5:39 am, Chino Valley Fire District units responded to 13920 City Center Drive in Chino Hills (Dillon's Restaurant & Irish Pub) for a call regarding an unknown liquid release inside of the restaurant. Several members of a cleaning crew reporting feeling ill after entering the business.

The unknown liquid was determined to be flammable and evidence of vandalism was discovered during the investigation. Investigators from Chino Valley Fire District as well as Chino Hills Police Department/San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department are actively investigating the circumstances of the incident, which occurred between the hours of midnight and 3 a.m.

City of Chino Hills Code Enforcement and San Bernardino County Department of Public Health have currently closed Dillon's Restaurant & Irish Pub until it can be properly cleaned and necessary repairs are made.
