DISCUSSION ITEMS:

2. Gandara announced Healthy Dinning program. She stated this program would be scheduled to start in 2017. Gandara stated this program would be collaborating with local restaurants within Chino Hills to introduce healthy meals.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS:
