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RESIDENT INPUT SOUGHT ON HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE NOVEMBER 30th 6:00 – 8:00 p.m.

Chino Hills, CA – Residents are invited to attend a community meeting to help the City of Chino Hills identify natural and man-made hazards in the community. The meeting will be held from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at Chino Hills City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive.

The City is required to update its Hazard Mitigation Plan every five years to ensure that natural and man-made hazards, and their potential impact on the community, are identified and up-to-date. Input is also sought on methods or techniques to reduce risks related to the identified hazards. With the updated Plan in place, the City maintains its eligibility for State and Federal Grant funding and is eligible to obtain FEMA Mitigation Grant Funds if a disaster is declared.
