

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADOPTION OF CITY OF CHINO HILLS  
ORDINANCE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on December 13, 2016, the City Council of the City of Chino Hills will consider adoption of a proposed Ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHINO HILLS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 5.28 OF THE CHINO HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROHIBIT ALL COMMERCIAL MARIJUANA ACTIVITY AND FINDING PROPOSED EXEMPT FROM REVIEW UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

The proposed Ordinance would amend Chapter 5.28 to expressly prohibit the operation of any marijuana cultivation facility, marijuana product manufacturing facility, marijuana testing facility, marijuana delivery business, marijuana storage facility, retail marijuana store, marijuana establishment, or any other commercial marijuana activity, as defined, in the City. The ordinance would also prohibit the cultivation of marijuana in the City, except for personal cultivation of up to six plants within a private residence when conducted in accordance with State law.
