Chino Hills, CA – Mayor Ray Marquez is seeking applications from Chino Hills residents who are interested in serving on the Parks and Recreation Commission. The vacancy is due to the resignation of Parks and Recreation Commissioner Dave Seltzer, who plans to move to another city. Interviews will be scheduled and Mayor Marquez is expected to nominate an individual at the April 11<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting. Members of the City Council must affirm the appointment. The new Commissioner's term will be effective through the end of Council Mayor Marquez' City Council term – November 2018.

The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to parks, recreation, community events, and programs. Commissioners work with community sports organizations and provide input to the design of park and recreation facilities.
