Schedule Announced for SCE Pavement Restoration Project on Eucalyptus Avenue

Chino Hills, CA – As part of a project to restore City roads affected by construction of the Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project, Southern California Edison and contractors Henkels & McCoy, Inc. and ASAP Paving announced the work schedule for a portion of the project occurring on Eucalyptus Avenue from Chino Hills Parkway to the west.

The work schedule (subject to change) is:

Wednesday, September 20th and Thursday, September 21st – The raised reflective markers and center-line striping will be removed and replaced with temporary markers.

Monday, September 25th and Tuesday, September 26th – Crack sealing will be completed from the west end of Eucalyptus Avenue to Chino Hills Parkway.

Wednesday, September 27th through Friday, September 29th – Slurry sealing (surface coating) work will begin at the west end, moving towards Chino Hills Parkway. Work will be done in phases to allow two-way traffic at all times on Eucalyptus Avenue. To aid the morning commute, contractors will not pass Avenida Del Monte before 9 a.m. and will avoid school traffic on Ridgeview Drive.

Monday, October 2nd and Tuesday, October 3rd – Work will begin on pavement markings including the centerline and lane lines. The final pavement markings will be applied and reflective markers will be added during the following week.

The schedule is subject to change. The project is expected to be complete by October 13th. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained and any lane closures must be cleared by 3:30 p.m. each day.
