STREET SWEEPING PARKING ENFORCEMENT TAKES A HOLIDAY

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills has declared a citation-free period for street sweeping day parking violations in order to accommodate the extra visitors expected in Chino Hills' neighborhoods during the holiday season. The City will not issue street sweeping parking tickets during the Thanksgiving holiday beginning Wednesday, November 22nd through Friday, November 24th. Enforcement will resume Monday, November 27th.

Enforcement will also be suspended for the Christmas holiday beginning Monday, December 18th through Tuesday, January 2nd. Sweeping enforcement will resume again on Wednesday, January 3rd.

Other types of parking tickets may be issued during this time period as this applies only to street sweeping parking tickets. For questions or concerns, residents can call the Public Works Department at (909) 364-2800.
