INCIDENT: Mail Theft / False Impersonation of Another Person / Stolen Access Cards / Possession of Controlled Substance / Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

LOCATION: Cottonwood Trail / Hillsborough Lane, Chino Hills

SUSPECT(S): Julian Garcia III, age 31, resident of Fontana
Jimmy Gonzalez, age 27, resident of Riverside

VICTIM(S): Multiple Residents of San Bernardino and Riverside Counties

SUMMARY: Deputy Drayer, of the Chino Hills Police Station, observed a suspicious vehicle, with no license plates, in the area of Hillsborough Lane and Cottonwood Trail. Drayer located two people, Jimmy Gonzalez and Julian Garcia, hiding in the vehicle. Garcia provided Drayer with false information and identified himself as another person. Gonzalez was found to be on probation, from Riverside County, for PC 530.5- Identity Theft. Once Garcia's true identity was established, he was found to be on probation, from San Bernardino County, for PC 459- Burglary.

During a search of the vehicle, Drayer located narcotics and drug paraphernalia. Drayer also located stolen credit cards and mail addressed to residents of Chino Hills. Drayer later discovered the mail had just been stolen.

Gonzalez was arrested and booked into West Valley Detention Center for PC 484e(b)- Possession of stolen access card, PC 530.5(e)- Mail theft, HS11377(a)- Possession of Narcotics and HS 11364(a)- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Garcia was also arrested and booked into West Valley Detention Center for PC 529- False Impersonation of Another, PC 530.5(e)- Mail Theft, and HS 11377(a)- Possession of Narcotics.
