SUSPECT(S): **Unknown male in a newer model, gray, box-type vehicle**

VICTIM(S): **16-year-old male**

SUMMARY: On August 25, 2018, at 9:55 p.m., deputies from the Chino Hills Station responded to a large party causing a disturbance in the 16700 block of Catena Drive. Around 11:35 p.m., deputies were flagged down regarding an injured male. Deputies determined the victim was assaulted by an unknown male who repeatedly punched and kicked him. During the assault, the suspect stole the victim's backpack. The victim suffered injuries as a result of this incident. The suspect is believed to have entered a newer model, gray, box type vehicle and fled the scene. The suspect was accompanied by other unknown individuals. A large amount of people were in the area and deputies believe there are witnesses who observed the incident.
