## COMMISSION APPLICATIONS SOUGHT

Chino Hills, CA – Recently-elected City Council Members Brian Johsz, Ray Marquez, and Peter Rogers are seeking applications from Chino Hills residents who are interested in serving on the Planning, Parks and Recreation, and Public Works Commissions.

Commission members serve a term that coincides with the term of their nominating Council Member. Terms of current appointees expire on November 30. Commissioners appointed by Council Members Johsz, Marquez, and Rogers must reapply if they are interested in continuing their service. These appointees are Planning Commissioners Michael Stover, Jerry Blum, and Stephen Romero; Public Works Commissioners Larry Rovira, Bob Goodwin, and Vincent Jones; and Parks and Recreation Commissioners R. Joe Schaffer, Al Jackson, and Greg Higgins. Council Members Johsz, Marquez, and Rogers have encouraged all to apply.

The application period begins on Monday, December 3. Applications will be available online at [www.chinohills.org/CommissionApplication](http://www.chinohills.org/CommissionApplication) and at Chino Hills City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, at the main reception desk on the second floor in the City Clerk's Lobby.

Interested persons should return a completed application to the Chino Hills City Clerk by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 4, 2019. Interviews may be scheduled at the Council Members' discretion. Council Members expect to make their nominations at the January 22 City Council meeting. Members of the City Council must affirm the appointment. The new Commissioners' terms will be effective through the end of their appointing Council Member's term: November 30, 2022.

The Planning Commission meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to development and building and safety. The Commission also reviews site plans, amendments to the Development Code and General Plan, residential designs, design standards, and development standards.

The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to parks, recreation, community events, and programs. Commissioners work with community sports organizations and provide input to the design of park and recreation facilities.

The Public Works Commission meets on the first Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. to review issues related to public safety, cable television, water, water rates, sewers, and roads. The Public Works Commission also considers traffic-related concerns such as stop signs, speed humps, and traffic signals.
