Chino Hills, CA – The last day to purchase a commemorative brick to add to the display at the entrance to the Chino Hills Community Center is Friday, Dec. 21. The Chino Hills Community Foundation launched a program in 2012, before construction on the building began, to sell commemorative bricks to raise funds to furnish the future facility. Plans call for the final brick installation in the spring of 2019.
