PLANNING COMMISSION APPLICATIONS SOUGHT DEADLINE FEBRUARY 26

Chino Hills, CA –Residents interested in serving on the Planning Commission are invited to complete an application. Council Member Peter Rogers will review the applications and nominate an individual to fill a vacancy created after Planning Commissioner Stephen Romero submitted his resignation. The Commissioner’s term coincides with Council Member Rogers term through November of 2022. Applications must be returned to the City Clerk’s Office on the second floor at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 26.

The Planning Commission meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. to review issues related to the physical development of the City. The Commission reviews subdivision maps, site plans, amendments to the Development Code and General Plan, residential designs, design standards, and development standards. Commissioners receive a \$25 stipend per meeting.

Interviews may be scheduled and Council Member Rogers plans to nominate an individual at the March 12 City Council meeting. Members of the City Council must affirm the appointment.

Completed applications are valid for a period of two years and will be considered if a vacancy occurs during that time.
