CHINO HILLS RESIDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE IRRIGATION SYSTEM TUNE-UP

Chino Hills, CA – Chino Hills residents are eligible for a free irrigation tune-up as part of a program to help residents reduce their outdoor water use. Program sponsors include the City of Chino Hills, Inland Empire Utilities Agency, Inland Empire WATERKEEPER, and the Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority.

“Our goal is to help residents reduce their water use,” said Nadeem Majaj, Chino Hills Public Works Director. “This program offers residents free help with their irrigation system and teaches them how to program the irrigation controller.”

Representatives from ConServ, Inc. will visit the home to evaluate the irrigation controller and irrigation system. Representatives will make recommendations, and may make repairs to irrigation valves and sprinklers, lateral irrigation lines, and drip irrigation lines, all at no cost to the participant. ConServ, Inc. will also teach residents how to set watering schedules.

A participation agreement is required, which grants permission for ConServ, Inc. to access to the property to perform the tune-up of the irrigation system, and allows program sponsors to review water use records to evaluate program results and water use patterns.
