PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION APPLICATIONS SOUGHT DEADLINE MAY 31

Chino Hills, CA –Residents interested in serving on the Parks and Recreation Commission are invited to complete an application. Vice Mayor Art Bennett will review the applications and nominate an individual to fill a vacancy created after Mayor Cynthia Moran appointed Parks and Recreation Commissioner Patrick Hamamoto to serve on the Planning Commission. Mr. Hamamoto will replace long-serving Planning Commissioner Adam Eliason, who recently resigned because he will no longer be a Chino Hills resident. Applications must be returned to the City Clerk’s Office on the second floor at City Hall, 14000 City Center Drive, by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 31. Interviews may be scheduled and Vice Mayor Bennett expects to nominate an individual at the June 11 City Council meeting. Members of the City Council must affirm the appointment.

The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. to review issues related to parks, recreation, community events, and programs. Commissioners work with community sports organizations and provide input to the design of park and recreation facilities.
