## **SHADYVIEW DRIVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT UNDERWAY FEBRUARY 24**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills' next pavement project will start on Monday, February 24. ADA ramp improvements at intersections will begin on Shady View Drive from Butterfield Ranch Road to south of Wrangler Road. Work hours will be from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The \$188,000 contract was awarded to Onyx Paving Inc., with funding providing by Community Facilities District 8.

No parking signs will be posted on Shady View Drive during the project. City staff provided notice to property managers for the Celamonte and Hampton communities that access into and out of their complexes will be available, but there will be periods of time that residents must exit by making a right-turn only. Residents may also have to make u turns to get into their complex. The contractor is providing additional notices. Various phases of work will be underway for approximately one month.
