CITY OF CHINO HILLS STARTS INTEREST LIST FOR DISCOUNTED FLUME SMART HOME WATER MONITORS

Chino Hills, CA – City of Chino Hills’ water customers are encouraged to contact the City to secure a place on the interest list for a limited number of Flume Smart Home Water Monitor units that will be available to Chino Hills residents at a discounted price of \$40 (retail value of \$199). Residents who live in single-family homes should send an email to waterconservation@chinohills.org to be notified of the program’s upcoming launch date and provided with a link to the online application.

The monitors will be offered as part of the Inland Empire Utilities Agency pilot program to help member agency residential water customers monitor their water use on a real-time basis.

According to Jake Loukeh, Water Use Efficiency Coordinator for the City of Chino Hills, the Flume device allows households to see real-time information on household water consumption, set water usage goals and budgets for the household, and detect small leaks before they cost money and cause damage.

“The Flume Water Sensor straps around the water meter and sends real-time water usage via Wi-Fi to the Flume Bridge,” said Mr. Loukeh. “If the system senses a leak or unusually high water use, the customer will be notified immediately via text, email, or push notification on their smart phone.”
