## **COVID-19 UPDATE: DOG PARK TO REOPEN WITH ADDITIONAL RULES STARTING MAY 30**

Chino Hills, CA – The Dog Park at Vila Borba Park will reopen to the public on Saturday, May 30 with additional rules in place to reduce community spread of COVID-19. Signage will be posted that capacity will be limited to 20 people on the large dog side, and 15 people on the small dog side to ensure that six feet of physical distance can be maintained between people who are not part of the same household. Face coverings are strongly recommended and visitors are encouraged to wash hands before and after visiting the Dog Park. Benches, picnic tables, and water fountains will be taped-off to reduce the concern over COVID-19 spread. Dog Park patrons are encouraged to bring their own lawn chair and water for their pet.

Park monitors will stop at the park to help educate the public to make them aware that the rules must be observed to ensure continued access to the Dog Park. Vila Borba Park is open 30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
