**COVID-19 TESTING AND FLU VACCINE EVENT SUCCESSFUL (NOVEMBER 18)
FUTURE COVID-19 TESTING EVENTS OFFERED IN CHINO HILLS
WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 2, 16 & JANUARY 6, 20**

Chino Hills, CA – The City of Chino Hills partnered with San Bernardino County Public Health and Fourth District County Supervisor Curt Hagman to offer free COVID-19 tests and flu shots in Chino Hills on November 18. The successful event resulted in a total of 535 COVID-19 tests administered and 113 flu shots given. According to S.B. Co. Public Health, the testing event broke some County records for the number of tests conducted in 4.5 hours while staff also provided flu shots.

Future free COVID-19 tests in Chino Hills will be offered on the first and third Wednesdays in December and January from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. The dates are December 2 and 16 and January 6 and 20. Tests will be conducted inside the barn at the McCoy Equestrian & Recreation Center, 14280 Peyton Drive. Face coverings are required. A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years old.

COVID-19 testing is encouraged for everyone. No symptoms are required to get a COVID-19 test. Walk-ins will be accepted while supplies last. The County of San Bernardino will activate appointment registration for testing events approximately five to seven days before the event date. Visit www.sbcounty.gov/dph/flu and select "County Testing Sites" to make an appointment or call (909) 387-3911. Additional COVID-19 testing locations are available on the website. Participants will be asked for health insurance information when registering but will never receive a bill. Participants will not be charged a co-pay nor share the cost for the test. Persons who do not have insurance or do not want to provide insurance will still be registered and tested.

Flu shots are recommended for pregnant women and individuals with chronic health conditions. Children ages three and older are eligible. A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years old.
