## **COVID-19 UPDATE: CITY OF CHINO HILLS EXTENDS CLOSURES THROUGH MAY 30**

Chino Hills, CA – Due to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Chino Hills will extend some facility closures through May 30. Extended facility closures include the McCoy Equestrian and Recreation Center, Sleepy Hollow Community Center, Mystic Canyon Building, and Grand Avenue Park Community Building. The Chino Hills Community Center is open for limited use of restrooms only. Street sweeping parking enforcement will not resume without further notice, at least through May 30. All park amenities including basketball courts, hockey rinks, pickleball courts, tennis courts, playgrounds, and outdoor exercise equipment are now open, with the exception of gazebo rentals. The warm-up arena at the McCoy Equestrian and Recreation Center is also open for individual equestrian and recreational use and arena restrooms are available for public use.

Visitors are encouraged to follow the recommended precautions to stop the spread of COVID-19 when visiting parks. These include limiting gatherings, maintaining physical distance of at least six feet, wearing face coverings over the mouth and nose for everyone two years of age or older, and hand washing or sanitizing frequently.

City Council and Commission meetings are being conducted via Zoom. Information on how to participate is noted on the first page of the meeting agendas. The Council Chambers is not open to the public during meetings. City Hall is open, and employees continue to provide City services via telephone, online, and in some cases by appointment. Facility openings and closures are subject to change and will be modified in accordance with health guidelines from the State of California and County of San Bernardino.
