✓ DO'S

- CONSULT YOUR VET ABOUT YOUR DOG'S OVERALL HEALTH BEFORE GOING TO A DOG PARK
- MAKE SURE YOUR PET IS UP-TO-DATE ON HIS/HER VACCINATIONS
- SUPERVISE YOUR DOG WHEN HE/SHE IS PLAYING AND INTERVENE IN ANY ROUGH PLAY
- TRAIN YOUR DOG TO PROPERLY GREET OTHER DOGS
- BE CAUTIOUS WHEN TAKING ADVICE FROM OTHER PARK VISITORS WHO ARE NOT DOG PROFESSIONALS
- REMOVE YOUR DOG IF HE/SHE IS NOT DISPLAYING GOOD BEHAVIOR
- TELL OTHERS HOW YOUR DOG SHOULD BE APPROACHED
- CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

DON'T'S ✗

- TAKE YOUR DOG TO A DOG PARK IF HE/SHE IS UNCOMFORTABLE AROUND OTHER DOGS
- LET YOUR DOG OFF A LEASH IF HE/SHE IS NOT RESPONSIVE TO YOUR VERBAL COMMANDS
- ALLOW YOUR DOG TO MOUNT ANOTHER DOG
- LEAVE YOUR DOG LEASH OR HARNESS ON WHILE YOUR DOG IS PLAYING
- BRING YOUR DOG TO THE DOG PARK IF SHE IS PREGNANT OR IN HEAT
- LET SMALL DOGS PLAY IN THE SAME AREAS AS BIG DOGS (VICE VERSA)
- IGNORE YOUR DOG AND HIS/HER BEHAVIOR
