



## City of Chino Hills Adult Soccer Code of Conduct

The safety and enjoyment of players is the City of Chino Hills' number one priority. The purpose of the Code of Conduct is to create, encourage, and set standards for ethical and fair treatment of all individuals, whether it is a team, player, manager, spectator, game official, or City of Chino Hills staff. As a participant of the Chino Hills Adult Soccer League, players are expected to meet the following requirements with regard to conduct for the duration of the program.

Player agrees he/she will **NOT**:

- Be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol \_\_\_\_\_
- Be verbally abusive towards any player, official, spectator, manager, or staff  
(This includes, profanity, racist/sexist/derogatory comments) \_\_\_\_\_
- Be physically aggressive towards any player, official, spectator, manager or staff \_\_\_\_\_
- Strike, lay hands on, push, or kick any player, official, spectator, manager, or staff \_\_\_\_\_
- Refuse to abide calls made by the referees \_\_\_\_\_
- Use obscene gestures towards any player, manager, spectator, game official, or staff \_\_\_\_\_
- Enter an area of activity to participate or provoke an altercation \_\_\_\_\_

### **Penalties:**

Minimum Penalty: Warning

Maximum Penalty: Permanent suspension from the City of Chino Hills Adult Soccer League

Reminders:

1. Managers/Captains are the only people allowed to talk with referees during the game, at half time, or at the end of the game about a call/dispute on the field.
2. Participants that receive 5 yellow cards and/or 2 red cards in a season will be placed on probation. Any further violation of the Code of Conduct will result in a suspension.
3. Suspended players are not allowed at the field during the term of their suspension. Failure to comply will result in the teams forfeit.
