## **Assemblywoman Chang Recognizes Councilwoman Cynthia Moran as Woman of the Year** *Longtime Community Leader and Popular Councilwoman Honored*

SACRAMENTO – Assemblywoman Ling Ling Chang (R-Diamond Bar), recognized and honored Councilwoman Cynthia Moran of Chino Hills, as the 55<sup>th</sup> Assembly District Woman of the Year today.

“Cynthia Moran has been an incredibly dedicated leader in her community,” said Assemblywoman Chang. “Her involvement in local Parent Teacher Associations, the Chino Hills Community Foundation, and countless organizations leading up to her election to her City Council demonstrate her commitment to our community. This recognition is long overdue,” Chang added.

Ms. Moran was elected to the Chino Hills City Council in 2012 and served as Mayor of Chino Hills in 2015. In addition to her responsibilities on the Council, she is a member of the California Department of Education Advisory Panel on Pathways to Graduation and interfaces with the Chino Valley Unified School Districts, and Chino Valley Independent Fire District. In 2009, she founded “Cyn in the City,” dedicating herself to engaging women and small businesses in the community.

Held annually, the Woman of the Year ceremony celebrates California’s extraordinary women. The first ceremony was held in 1987 to help commemorate Women’s History Month. The event has become an annual Capitol tradition to salute women who have offered their communities outstanding service. Prior to serving in the Legislature, Assemblywoman Chang was honored as a “Woman of the Year” in 2006. Honorees are presented with a framed certificate from the State Assembly recognizing their outstanding contributions during a ceremony in the Assembly chambers.
