## **TEMPORARY SHADE STRUCTURES**

A temporary shade structure is defined as an accessory structure that that lacks a permanent foundation and walls. A temporary shade structure has a cover/roof constructed from fabric, fiberglass, plastic or metallic material. A temporary shade structure provides shade and protection from the elements for people and vehicles\*.

## **Provisions and Limitations**

- 1. A temporary shade structure may not encroach into any required yard setback area.
- 2. A temporary shade structure may not be located in any front yard area between the front property line and a line extending from the front corners or the structure to the side property line.
- 3. A maximum of one temporary shade structure is allowed on a lot at any one time.
- 4. A temporary shade structure can only be maintained on a property for a maximum period of 90 cumulative days in a 12-month period.
- 5. A temporary shade structure may not exceed 400 square feet in size or 15 feet in overall height.
- 6. A temporary shade structure may not be attached to a permanent structure
- 7. A temporary shade structure may not block or cover a required vehicle access easement and/or driveway to a required garage, carport or required offsite parking area.

## **Development Standards**

- 1. If the temporary shade structure is used for vehicle storage it must be located a minimum of 3 feet from any habitable portion of the house.
- 2. The temporary shade structure must be located a minimum of 3 feet from any bed room window.
- 3. The frame of the temporary shade structure shall be constructed, braced and anchored to prevent any instability/collapse. The covering/roof material shall be securely attached to the frame and if constructed of fabric material it shall meet the flame retardant requirements specified within the California Fire Code.

## **Maintenance Standards**

- 1. Temporary shade structures shall be maintained in good condition, without tears, rips, dents or deterioration from the sun and weather.
- 2. Temporary shade structures shall be kept free of junk or other stored materials.

\*Inoperable vehicles are prohibited from being stored under temporary shade structures. Inoperable vehicles may only be stored within an entirely enclosed building.
