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2018 Boat Parade Participation Agreement

The information listed below reflects the terms listed on the Participation Agreement. This document should be kept by parade applicants for reference and to educate all passengers about expectations while participating in the 2018 Boat Parade

- ◆ All entrants must sign a waiver and release form.
- ◆ Participants must provide a copy of Proof-of-Tow-Vehicle liability insurance.
- ◆ Trailer/Boat: Boats must be 32' or less in length and 13' or less in height at the highest point; if a sail-boat, the mast must be down.
- ◆ No jet skis, seadoos, or any other ancillary vehicles may be towed.
- ◆ No alcohol allowed in vehicles or towed boats.
- ◆ No driving to and from the event with passengers in towed boats.
- ◆ Entrants agree to participate for the entire parade.
- ◆ Boats must be decorated with lights; power generation is the responsibility of the owner. Decoration of the towing vehicle is optional at the owner's discretion.
- ◆ No items (candy, glow sticks, etc.) shall be thrown from boats or tow vehicles. Parade participants are welcome to walk along side boats and lightly toss items into the crowd.
- ◆ No confetti shall be thrown by parade participants.
- ◆ No Santa Claus costumes allowed.
- ◆ Business sponsors (\$300 donation) must receive pre-approval of all banners and other promotion ideas.
- ◆ Full cooperation with law enforcement is expected and appreciated.

By signing the official 2018 Boat Parade Participation Agreement, the applicant agrees to comply with the logistical and behavioral expectations set forth by the Kiwanis Club of Chino Hills. Additionally, the applicant agrees to communicate all rules and expectations with all passengers that may be riding in boats and/or tow vehicles. Finally, the applicant agrees to listen to and follow direction that may be given by members of the Kiwanis Club of Chino Hills and/or City of Chino Hills staff. The applicant understands that failing to comply with one or more of the expectations listed above may result in loss of future opportunities to participate in the annual Boat Parade.
