Road Closures and Parade-Viewing Tips



The Chino Hills Boat Parade, presented by the Kiwanis Club of Chino Hills, begins promptly at 7:00 p.m. at the corner of Eucalyptus Avenue and Peyton Drive. (Only registered boats will be allowed to participate.) A map is posted on the City website at www.chinohills.org/BoatParade. Parade spectators should arrive early if they plan to park at Ayala High School (see details under “Parking”). All parking lot/street closures are for the safety of the public. Stop by the “After Party” hosted by Chino Valley Community Church, 14601 Peyton Drive. Please note – Boys Republic is private property and there are no viewing areas for the public.

Rain or Shine!

The parade will be held rain or shine. After all, boats are meant to handle the water! Parade organizers will coordinate closely with public safety officials and expect to cancel ONLY if there is a real danger to public health and safety such as lightning or flooding. So bundle up and bring umbrellas and rain ponchos if it’s raining. The Field Conditions hotline will provide information regarding any weather-related concerns/cancellations. ***Road Closures** Parade Route Closed from 5:00 – 9:00 p.m. (approximate times)

5:00: Eucalyptus Avenue closed from Peyton Drive west to Galloping Hills Road

NOTE TO REGISTERED PARADE ENTRIES, PARTICIPANTS, AND MEDIA – You must access the Eucalyptus Avenue parade staging area near Chino Hills Community Park (CHCP) from Chino Hills Parkway – NO EXCEPTIONS. No access to the CHCP parking lot after 6:30 p.m. Vehicles may NOT exit CHCP from 5:00 p.m. until the parade ends. PARTICIPANTS may park at CHCP to walk to their entry ONLY if they will leave their car at CHCP. Participants being dropped off must exit their vehicles at Galloping Hills Road to walk to their parade entry.

- 5:00: Eucalyptus Avenue from Boys Republic Fire Road (west of Pipeline Avenue), westbound to Peyton Drive closed to through traffic – residents only
 Boys Republic Drive closed south of Shoppes Drive to Peyton Drive
 Peyton Drive closed to through traffic south of Payne Ranch Road/Post Office, except for English Road residents and motorists heading to Ayala High School, via Bulldog Blvd., for parade parking.
 Southbound access ends at 6:00 p.m.
- 6:00: Northbound Peyton Drive closed at Morningfield Drive, except for motorists heading to Chino Valley Community Church, 14601 Peyton Drive, for parade parking.
- 6:45: Eucalyptus Avenue from Boys Republic Fire Road (near Pipeline Avenue) west to Peyton Drive closed to traffic in both directions for the duration of the parade, from approximately 6:45 to 8:30 p.m.
 Residents in the neighborhoods across from the Litel Elementary area may turn right on eastbound Eucalyptus Avenue to exit the area until the parade reaches Eucalyptus Avenue)

***Parking**

- Ayala High School– Parking lot closes to vehicles at approximately 6:00 p.m.
 Parade spectators are advised to arrive early if they plan to park at Ayala High School. Peyton Drive closes north of Eucalyptus Avenue at 5:00 p.m. Between 5:00 and 6:00 p.m., the ONLY route to Ayala High School is on Peyton Drive, southbound from Grand Avenue. There will be a road closure (for through traffic) at the Payne Ranch Road/Post Office signal. Motorists heading south to Ayala High School to park will be allowed through the road closure, to Bulldog Blvd., to enter the parking lot. Right turn exit only, after parade is well out of the area.
- The Shoppes Overflow Parking Lot south of Shoppes Drive

- Government Center / Library Parking Lot (after 5:00 p.m. access ONLY from City Center Drive southbound from The Shoppes).
- Government Center / Shoppes Parking Structure (after 5:00 p.m. access ONLY from Shoppes Drive or City Center Drive southbound from The Shoppes).
- Chino Valley Community Church, 14601 Peyton Drive (“After Party” Location). After 5:00 p.m., access ONLY from Peyton Drive, heading northbound from Chino Hills Parkway. Motorists planning to park at CVCC will be allowed through road closure at Morningfield Drive).

*Timing of closures are subject to change at the discretion of public safety officials to protect the safety of the public.

Viewing Area Tips

For the first time ever, announcers near the Ayala High School monument will provide commentary and introduce parade participants.

Parade spectators should find a place on the east side of Peyton Drive in front of the Church of Latter Day Saints, Ayala High School, and Saint Paul the Apostle Catholic Church; or on the north side of Boys Republic Drive along the Government Center property all the way to Shoppes Drive

One of the best viewing areas for the parade is on Boys Republic south of Shoppes Drive, and a great location to find a viewing spot. The most congested viewing areas are: at the intersection of Eucalyptus Avenue and Peyton Drive; Peyton Drive just north of Eucalyptus Avenue; and the intersection of Peyton Drive and Boys Republic Drive

Boat Parade “After Party”

A free “After Party” will be held at Chino Valley Community Church, 14601 Peyton Drive, just south of Eucalyptus Avenue. Boat Parade trophies will be awarded to the winning entries. Enjoy seeing some of the boats from the parade up close! Refreshments will be available and there will be activities for kids.
