## **DUTIES OF PLANNING COMMISSION**

The duties of the Planning Commission shall be those described by the Government Code of the State of California (Section 65100 et seq.) and Chino Hills Municipal Code, Chapter 2.36. The Commission shall act as custodian of the visual character of the City and shall also have the following functions:

- Planning for the physical development of the City.
- Carry out the precepts and intent of the City's Zoning Ordinance.
- Review and approve, conditionally approve or deny tentative subdivision maps.
- Make recommendations to the City Council for the establishment of appropriate zoning boundaries for new annexations to the City.
- Review the General Plan and make a report thereon annually to the City Council.
- Periodically review the Zoning Map and the text and the Zoning Ordinance and make recommendations to the City Council for change.
- Periodically review the Subdivision Ordinance and make recommendations to the City Council for amendments or additions.
