State Route 71 Fiber Optic Installation Project

in Chino Hills

Weeknight Lane Closures

June 13 – June 17, 2022

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting the public that construction contractors will perform work for the fiber optic communications project on State Route 71 (SR-71) in the City of Chino Hills. This project involves installing Transportation Management System (TMS) field elements and a fiber optic communication system. Work will occur north-bound (NB) and south-bound (SB) between the Los Angeles/San Bernardino County line and State Route 91 (SR-91).

Weather permitting.

The work is scheduled to take place NIGHTLY on Monday, June 13 through Friday, June 17 from 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Weeknight work concludes Saturday, June 18 at 7:00 a.m. Installation of conduit will occur on ramps, mainline and high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes. **Please note: These closures are dependent on contractor receiving proper materials for each job function. They can be changed or canceled at any time.**

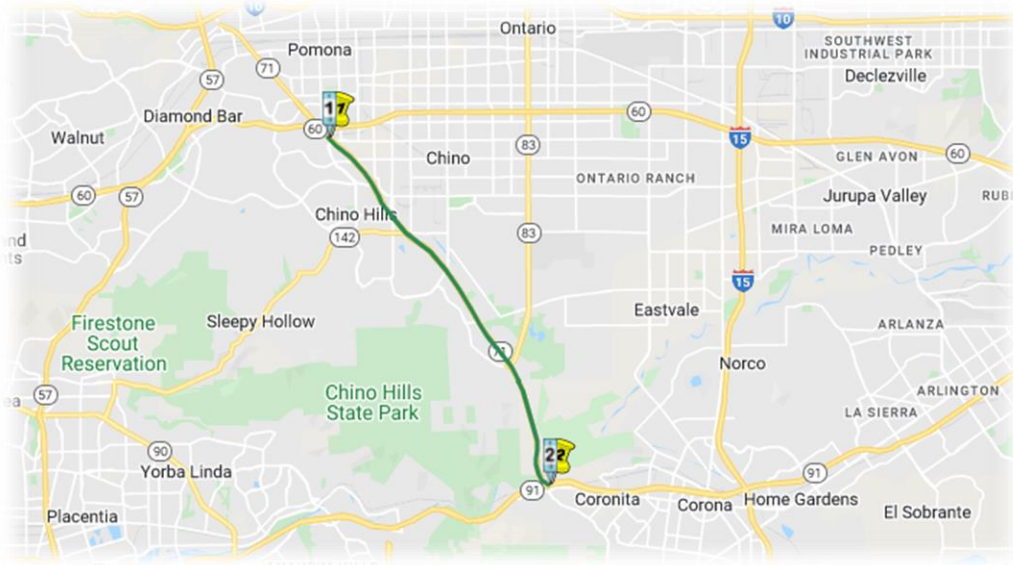
The following are planned work locations and alternating ramp closures:

**Interstate 10 / State Route 71 Pavement Delineation
in Bloomington & Chino Hills
Weeknight Ramp Closures
June 12 - 17, 2022**

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting the public that construction contractors will perform pavement delineation work on Interstate 10 (I-10) in the City of Bloomington and State Route 71 (SR-71) in the City of Chino Hills. Work will occur east-bound (EB) and west-bound (WB) between Cypress Avenue and Riverside Ave, north-bound (NB) and south-bound (SB) between County Line and Garey Ave. *Weather permitting.*

The work is scheduled to take place NIGHTLY on Sunday, June 12 through Friday, June 17 from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Pavement marking operations will occur on I-10 and SR-71 off and on-ramps. Please note: These closures are dependent on contractor receiving proper materials for each job function. They can be changed or canceled at any time.

- *Euclid Ave. / SR-83 off-ramp*

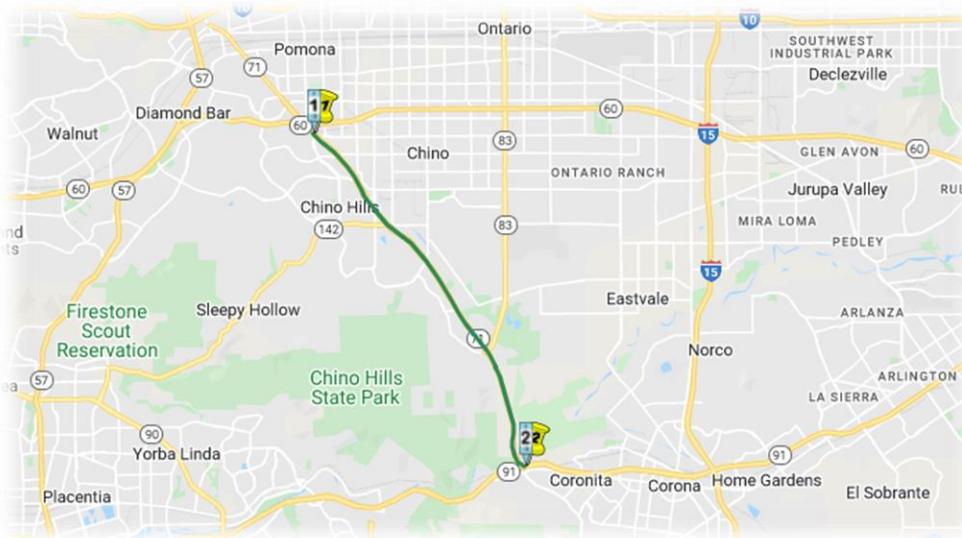
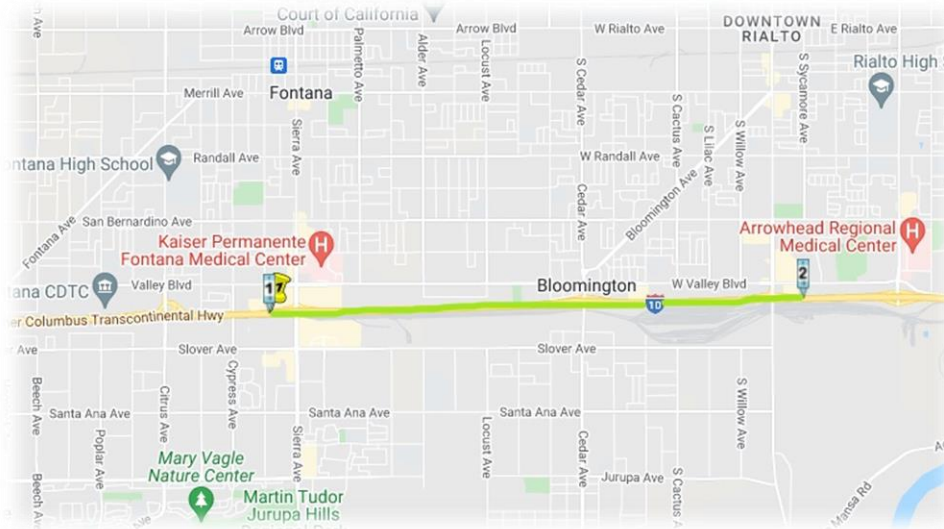
SR-10 (EB/WB):
