Subject: Southern California Edison (SCE) Construction Activities in Your Area:

Placement of New Electrical Transmission Structures Near This Location

Dear Resident/Property Owner:

Southern California Edison (SCE) Company's Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project (TRTP) is currently under construction. This project will deliver clean renewable wind energy to the Los Angeles basin and Inland Empire and strengthen SCE's electrical system. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your patience during construction of this important project.

Within the next few days, a new steel electrical transmission structure (approximately 195 ft. in height) will be placed in the utility corridor near this property.

Electrical transmission wire (220 kilovolt) was recently removed and upgraded wire (500 kilovolt) will be installed in the project area at a later date.

Crews will continue making every effort to limit construction to the hours of **7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday.** However, it may be necessary at times of unforeseen conditions for crews to continue project activities within the utility right-of-way beyond that time.

Tips for Minimizing Construction Impacts

SCE is committed to minimizing any inconvenience and ensuring public safety during this work. In addition to SCE efforts to minimize the impacts to residents and businesses during construction, here are some simple tips that may help you reduce construction disturbance:

- Close all windows and doors facing the construction area in order to reduce noise and dust.
- Watch for information updates to ensure you have the most up-to-date information about construction activities taking place in your area.
