Chino Hills: Construction Update

During October 10 – 14, 2011, construction in the city of Chino Hills as part of Southern California Edison's (SCE's) Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project (TRTP) will include the activities listed below.

Please note – construction hours: Crews will continue making every effort to limit construction to the hours of **7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday.** However, it may be necessary at times of unforeseen conditions for crews to continue project activities within the utility right-of-way beyond that time.

Every effort will be made to reduce the amount of noise generated by the following construction activities:

- Continue assembly of steel materials and installation of new electrical transmission structures:
 - Three lattice steel structures
