Emergency Notifications

- ► Telephone Emergency Notification System (TENS)
- High-speed mass notification during an evacuation or natural disaster
- ► A database of landline telephone numbers to send emergency messages to landline phones
- ► The database is updated every six months
- Register your cellular phone to receive emergency text messages and to access a library of emergency preparedness

Emergency Notifications

- ➤ Smart911 allows citizens to provide the additional details that 9-1-1 call takers may need to assist them during an emergency
- Smart911 recognizes your phone number and displays your profile
- ► Smart911 is free, private and secure
- ▶ Be prepared, sign up before an emergency happens

Evacuation Procedures

- ▶ Officials will determine the areas to be evacuated and the routes to use depending on the disaster.
- Law enforcement agencies are responsible for enforcing an evacuation order.
- ► You will be advised of potential evacuations as early as possible.
- ► Have a plan with your family and neighbors that may need assistance.
- ► Take the initiative to stay informed and aware. Register for emergency alerts before disaster strikes.







Evacuation Procedures

- Once evacuated, you will not be let back until it is safe to return.
- If you see City personnel manning a road closure, they are providing law enforcement with extra manpower. They do not have the authority to allow you access to an evacuated area once you leave.
- ► If you feel like you are in danger-LEAVE!
- ▶ Be ready to evacuate as soon as you know danger is near.









Be Prepared

Back your car into the driveway for a quick escape

Have at least a half tank of gas Keep important documents filed in a box

Have cell phone charged; portable chargers packed

Listen to radio/TV for announcements from law enforcement and emergency personnel.

You may be directed to temporary assembly areas to await transfer to a safe location.

California law authorizes officers to restrict access to any area where a menace to public health or safety exists due to a calamity such as flood, storm, fire, earthquake, explosion, accident or other disaster. Refusal to comply is a misdemeanor. (Penal Code 409.5)
