1. Play in groups

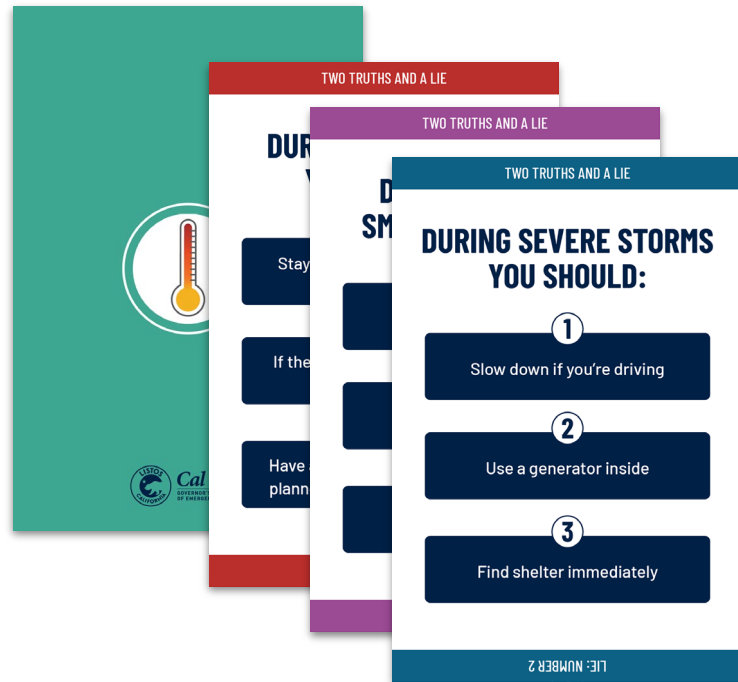
This game does not need to be hosted, can be played in small groups during the event.

TWO TRUTHS & A LIE

ACTIVITY:

Take turns reading the cards to your table mates and guessing the lie, the answer can be found at the bottom of each card.

TWO TRUTHS AND A LIE

GAME GUIDE



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INSTRUCTIONS:

Read out the prompt of each card and the three tips and ask your group what is the lie. Once a guess has been made, read out the lie found at the bottom of the card. Lie explanations are found below.

LIES EXPLAINED:



EXTREME HEAT: During extreme heat, multiple days and nights of hot weather can be very dangerous. Getting too hot can make people sick. Stay in air-conditioned buildings, find public places to cool down, and take breaks if working outside.



WILDFIRES: During wildfires know the difference between an evacuation warning and an evacuation order. An evacuation warning means get ready to leave. An evacuation order means leave immediately.



WILDFIRE SMOKE: During wildfire smoke, turn off ventilation fans or anything allowing outdoor air to enter. Set your air conditioning to reuse air that's already in the house.



POWER OUTAGE: During power outages, get flashlights or lanterns with extra batteries, and surge protectors for sensitive devices. Do not use candles or oil lanterns for light.



FAST & COLD WATER: During fast & cold water, if you jump in after someone, you could be swept away yourself, instead try throwing something to them like a life vest.



FLOODS: During floods, if trapped inside by floodwaters, move to higher floors or a roof, but not attics.



EARTHQUAKES: During earthquakes, if inside, do not rush outside or stand in a doorway. Never use elevators! Remember, DROP, COVER, and HOLD ON.

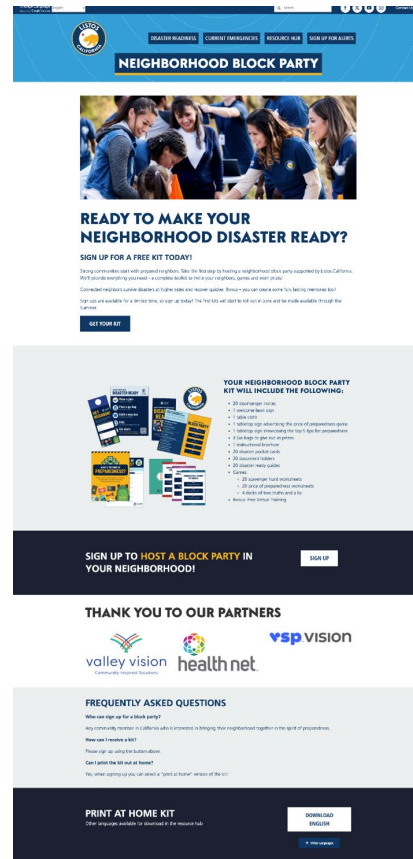


SEVERE STORMS: During severe storms, use a generator outside only, at least 20 feet from doors and windows. Indoors, its poisonous exhaust can kill in minutes.
